



Parent's Contract

The following policies regarding the conduct of SKY Volleyball Team Parents are being established in support of the Player Code of Character and Conduct.

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT and SUPPORT

- Be supportive of, and reinforce all elements of the Athlete Code of Character and Conduct, on and off the court
- Let the coaches instruct, position players, and handle the running of the game
- If you have a complaint or problem with anyone on the coaching staff, go to the club director
- If you have concerns regarding the team and how it is being run, discuss it with the club director
- Participate in and contribute to the food preparation for tournaments so the Athlete will have ample fluids and snacks to sustain her throughout the game
- Reinforce a healthy diet, on and off the court
- Make all necessary travel arrangements
- Make all fee payments in accordance with the payment schedule

INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT

The following inappropriate behaviors will not be tolerated:

- Allowing an Athlete to leave the bench to sit with you (except in an emergency situation) - send her back to the bench
- Questioning playing time
- Use of crude, profane or vulgar language
- Outward displays of displeasure with the officials
- Consumption of alcohol and/or drugs at practice or tournament facilities
- Critical, judgmental, or negative talk directed toward teammates and opposing team members
- Late or non-payment of fees (Note: All amended payment schedules between the Director and the Parent must be approved by the Board.)

Consequences of the above actions:

- The Parent will be asked by the Coach or the Club Director to stop the inappropriate behavior
- If a Parent has offended an Official or disrespected a Coach, he/she will be requested to leave the court area
- If the Parent does not cease from the behavior or refuses to leave the court area when asked, the Athlete may be pulled out of a game, temporarily suspended from participating in future games and other team activities, or possibly even dismissed from the team
- If an Athlete is dismissed from the team for a Parent Code of Conduct violation, the Parent will be responsible for any additional costs, and NO refunds will be given
- If a Parent fails to comply with the fee payment schedule (after a 7 days grace period), and an adjustment to the schedule has not been agreed upon between the Parent and the Club Director, the Athlete will not be permitted to practice nor compete until the Parent becomes current on all fees
- In the absence of an amended payment schedule, an Athlete will be dismissed from the Club if payment is not received within 14 days after the due date indicated on the fee payment schedule.

All decisions, including dismissal and amended payment schedule, are at the discretion of the SKY Volleyball Leadership Team.

PARENT RELEASE

I hereby grant my daughter permission to participate in all SKY Volleyball activities, including clinics and post-season tournaments not specifically scheduled. I acknowledge that these activities may require travel in various modes of transportation, with accommodations and meals in various establishments.

I acknowledge that my daughter participates in all SKY Volleyball activities at his/her own risk. In consideration of your permitting her to participate, I hereby accept any inherited risk of play, participation or travel, and hereby release SKY Volleyball, the league in which the team competes, and/or any other national or local organization/association with which SKY Volleyball may affiliate, and the officers, coaching staff, sponsors, volunteers, officials, employees, agents, affiliates, heirs, successors, and assigns of each from any responsibility that you or they might have regarding the health and physical condition of my daughter during her participation.

On behalf of myself, my son/daughter, our heirs, executors, and assigns, I further release and forever discharge all of the above individuals and entities from any and every claim, demand, right or cause of action either in law or in equity arising from my son's/daughter's participation in all activities. The undersigned agrees to indemnify and hold harmless all of the above individuals and entities from any claim made in derogation of this release.

I hereby give SKY volleyball, (hereafter, "SKY") the absolute and irrevocable right and permission, with respect to the photographs or video footage taken of my daughter and recorded on any medium when involved with official SKY events (practices, tournaments, community activities);

a. To use, re-use, publish and re-publish the same in whole or in part, individually or in conjunction with other photographs, videos or images, in any medium, including, but not limited to, posting on its web site, for the sole purpose of the advancement the SKY organization.

I hereby release SKY, a non-profit organization, each and every member of the Board of Directors, its employees, agents, assigns and any designee from any and all claims and demands arising out of or in connection with the use of such photographs, including but not limited to any claims for defamation or invasion of privacy.
